 - running a yearly conference

 - providing informations on best practices and their implementation
 - running a forum to discuss current developments of the internet
 - supporting researches with knowledge, contacts and infrastructure
- has ~216 members
- offers membership to individuals and legal bodies (e.g. companies)
- is the legal body running the conference
- yearly membership fee of 30 EUR
